NRA Registered Outdoor 2700 Precision Pistol Match  
CMP .22 Rimfire and Service Pistol EIC Matches and NRA Distinguished Revolver Match  
**THE RESULTS FOR THE CMP MATCHES AND THE NRA DR MATCH FROM BOTH**  
**LOCATIONS WILL BE COMBINED TO DETERMINE THE WINNER**

Match Schedule: One 2700 relay each day at both match locations. Times will be 0900 for both days at Wilkes Barre.

At Moraine the times will be as follows: Friday 10 Aug, 1200 Noon, Saturday 11 Aug, at 0900. And Sunday 12 Aug, at 1000. 2700 match will be fired

CMP Rimfire and Service Pistol EIC Matches will be conducted in accordance with CMP rules after all 2700 firing is completed on each day, at both locations. Distinguished Revolver match may be fired along with Service Pistol match if competitor is not firing Service Pistol. No EIC centerfire pistols will fire on the line when the EIC.22 Rimfire stage of the match is conducted. Moraine will conduct 2 relays only after the 2700 match is concluded. **Both CMP EIC Matches and NRA Distinguished Revolver Match Scores will be combined from both locations for all 3 days.**

Eligibility: Open to all competitors, PA State Champion must be a member in good standing of the PA Rifle & Pistol Assoc.

Divisions: This will be an OPEN DIVISION match only per NRA rules.

Classes & Categories: NRA system will be used. If fewer than four (4) entries in a class, competitors will be moved to their respective categories in the next higher class. Reserve participants, National Guard, full time Police officers will fire in the SERVICE CLASS.

Rules: All current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will be in effect for these matches. CMP regulations will be in effect for EIC matches.

Classification: NRA classification system will used in all matches. Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 (Assigned Classification) and Temporary Scorebooks may also be used.

Facilities: The Moraine location is equipped with 15 firing points and Wilkes-Barre is equipped with 28 points. Both firing lines are covered.

Squadding: Squadding will be on a first come first served basis with preference given to competitors intending to fire the complete 2700 point match. The 2700 point aggregate will be fired in one day.

Advanced Entries: Advanced entries are requested as we expect each relay to be full, therefore, your advance entry will assure your preference and help to make registration smoother. If a relay is full you will be notified. Post entries will be accepted to the limit of range capacity.

Challenges: A \$1.00 challenge fee will be charged. See NRA Rule 16.1 for procedures used.

Match Conditions: Scoring will be done downrange. Competitors will be responsible for repairing their target and making sure all bullet holes are covered. Competitors and scorers must sign scorecards. Range personnel only are authorized to use scoring plugs. Cell phones and pagers must be turned off on the firing line.

CMP EIC Matches: There will be both a .22 Rimfire EIC and a Service Pistol EIC match scheduled after the 2700 match. The scores from both locations and all days will be combined and reported as one match to the CMP.

Distinguished Revolver Match: Distinguished Revolver Match will also be offered. This match will be fired after the .22 Rimfire EIC (no Centerfire pistol will be fired on the rimfire EIC relay). At Moraine there will be only 2 relays after the 2700 is completed.

Awards: Awards will be cash. There will be an OPEN winner in addition to class awards in each match. The OPEN winner is not eligible for class awards. Classes will be combined upward if less than four (4) competitors are in a classification. If there are fewer than four (4) High Master (and Master if combined) they will compete for OPEN awards only. There must be at least four (4) competitors in a class to qualify for an award, an additional award will be given for an additional 4 competitors. **These awards will be calculated at the location the competitor fired the match. The overall State Champion, Woman Champion, and Junior Champion (if applicable) will be awarded a plaque from the PRPA.**

2700 Relays: There are different times for the relays at the hosting clubs. They are as follows:

Wilkes-Barre- The 2700 relays start at 0900 and EIC and DR matches will be fired after completion of 2700.

Moraine- on Friday, 10 August, relay starts at 1200 Noon.

On Saturday, 11 August, relay starts at 09:00 AM

On Sunday, 12 August, relay starts at 10:00 AM

EIC and DR relays will follow after 2700 relays are completed.

Refreshments: Locations will handle differently. Check with match director when making reservations.

Directions to Wilkes Barre: From interstate 81 Take exit 164 and follow Route 29 North 5 miles to Route 11 South. Follow Route 11 South approx. 5 miles until traffic light. Turn right onto "Main Rd." (If you pass the UGI power plant on the left, you went 400 yards too far) Travel 5.5 miles to Range Rd. (on right) Follow Range rd 0.9 miles and go through the gate, bear left through the gate to the clubhouse. From Route 11 South Follow Route 11 through Shickshinny and look for UGI Power Plant on the right. Left at traffic light onto "Main Rd." and travel 5.5 miles to Range Rd. (on right) Follow Range rd. 0.9 miles and go through the gate, bear left through the gate to the clubhouse.

Easy landmarks, look for Countryside Qwikmart and The Country Crab Saloon on the left, Range Rd. is second right, about 1/4 mile after Crab Saloon. SHOULD YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE CALL 570-256-7877 someone will be there from 5:00AM on.

Directions to Moraine: From US Rt 80. Take US RT 8 south to Staff Road. Right turn at Light. Cross Muddy Creek Road about 1 mile to Moraine Conservation Sportsmen's club on right.

From US Rt 422. Exit at US Rt 8 North. Go past Clearview Mall and bear left on Rt 8. About 8 miles to Staff Road Light. Left turn, across Muddy Creek Road and then 1 mile to Moraine Conservation Sportsmen's Club on the left.
